**ORDINANCE 116**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER AVAILABILITY AS STATED IN VILLAGE ORDINANCE NO. 102

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE VILLAGE OF LOS RANCHOS DE ALBUQUERQUE:


WHEREAS, the definition of public sanitary sewer availability as stated in Village Ordinance No. 102, Section 3 is impracticable;

NOW THEREFORE, the governing body of the Village of Los Ranchos de Albuquerque does hereby amend Ordinance #102, Section 3 to read as follows:


SECTION 3. Private Liquid Waste Systems Prohibited. No person shall install or modify a private liquid waste system or use a private liquid waste system that was installed or modified after public sanitary sewer service has become available. A public sanitary sewer may be considered available to any lot when such lot is within two hundred (200) feet of public sanitary sewer.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that all provisions and amendments of Ordinance #102 not amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
